PHASES OF THE CENSUS.

1st Phase (November 2022)
Ras Al Khaimah Census fieldworker(s) list all housing units and establishments in preparation for the second phase.

2nd Phase (February 2023)
Fieldworker(s) return to all housing units to gather more information about the families and the individuals residing in them.

WHAT IS THE RAS AL KHAIMAH CENSUS?

It is the process of counting the entire population of both citizens and non-citizens living in the Emirate and collecting information on living, educational, and social conditions of individuals and households.



WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE GENERAL POPULATION CENSUS OF THE EMIRATE OF RAS AL KHAIMAH?

By providing accurate demographic data, the census will help the government of Ras Al Khaimah to better understand the current and anticipated future needs of the growing population, such as healthcare, education, and public services. It also enables the review and update of policies and development plans to ensure the wellbeing and prosperity of citizens and residents.



HOW WILL THE RAS AL KHAIMAH CENSUS 2023 BE CONDUCTED?

The assigned fieldworker(s) will visit all buildings and residential units and count every individual living or working there. The census counts individuals of all age groups, be they citizens, residents, or visitors.



Phase One November 2022

Counting and classifying all housing units and establishments in the Emirate and collecting simple information about the household



Phase Two February 2023

Visiting each household and meeting the head of the family or their representative to gain more in-depth information on individuals residing there



WHAT KIND OF INFORMATION WILL FIELDWORKERS ASK FOR DURING THE SECOND PHASE?

Demographic characteristics: age, gender, and nationality.

Educational qualifications: educated or uneducated and educational level.

Marital status: (married or single)
The number of births of married women.

Health insurance for citizens and residents.

People of determination and chronic diseases.

The workforce includes economic activity, employees, and the unemployed.

Durable goods: like cars, smartphones, and conditioning.

The census fieldworker(s) will not ask for data on individuals' residency or legal status in the country.

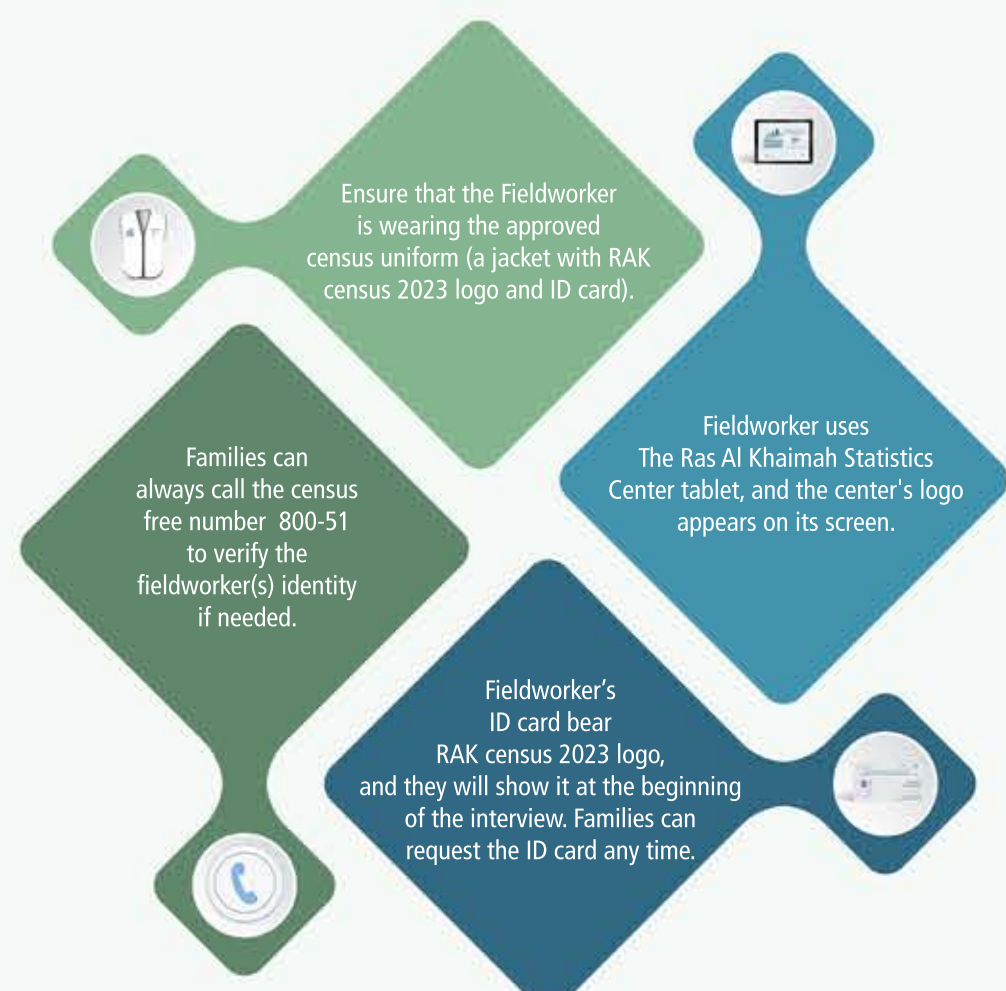
Dwelling characteristics: Number of rooms and connection to public services.

IS THE POPULATION'S DATA CONFIDENTIAL AND SECURE?

The information collected during the census process will be treated as strictly confidential and used for statistical purposes only. Accordingly, it will not be shared with any other party as per with the UN for official statistical work and as per with the law establishing the Ras Al Khaimah Statistics Center.

HOW TO VERIFY THE IDENTITY OF THE RAS AL KHAIMAH CENSUS FIELDWORKER(S)?

Anyone can verify the identity of the Ras Al Khaimah census fieldworker(s):



It is the first official census to be carried out locally at the level of the Emirate. Your cooperation and support will help the fieldworker to collect accurate data.
