A quarterly bulletin issued by Ras Al Khaimah Center for Statistics, contains foreign trade data received from the Customs Department in Ras Al Khaimah, which includes trade movement data made through the emirate's ports.



مركسز وأمن الفوقسة للإحصاء Ran Al Khairush Statistics Center Foreign trade Statistics are important statistics, they enable the production of a wide group of statistical indicators that show movement of goods that entered or exited from emirates ports (Marine, land, and air). The department of customs in Ras Al Khaimah is the main source of the data, as it monitors the trade movement through 12 custom centers in the emirate.

The data in the report, covers all the trade movement through the emirate's ports to the outside world; it does not include trade transactions of Ras Al Khaimah done through the ports in other emirates. The center has adopted the general trade system in producing trade data based on international recommendations to adopt this system to produce the data.

The center extends its sincere thanks to the customs department in Ras Al Khaimah for its full collaboration with the center in providing the data to produce the foreign trade statistics.




Concepts and Terminology

• The economic territory: is the area under the effective economic control of a single Government in which it gets things done effectively.

• The General trade system and the Special trade system: The general trade system is in use when the statistical territory in a country coincides with the economic territory. While the special trade system is in use when the statistical territory comprises only a particular part of the economic territory.




Special trade system



Trade Balance

The trade balance has a surplus of 1967 million dirhams in the third quarter of 2023, increasing by 12% in comparison with the second quarter of 2023, and has increased by 27% in comparison with the same quarter of the previous year.



Imports

The total imports were 2241 million dirhams in the third quarter of 2023, compared with 1994 million dirhams in the second quarter of 2023, increasing by 12%, and comparing it with the same guarter of the previous year, the data showed that the increase was approximately 22%.

As for the country of origin, 17% of the imports were from China, 12% from the United States, and 11% from India. As for the types of imported goods, the data showed that the imports of foodstuffs, beverages, spirits, and tobacco products were in the first place, with a value of around 427 million dirhams, followed by mineral products with 403 million dirhams, machinery and mechanical appliances, electrical equipment with 382 million dirhams.










In comparison with the second quarter of 2023, exports increased by 10% in the third quarter of 2023 and reached around 3579 million dirhams in the third quarter of 2023. By comparing it with the third quarter of the previous year (2022), it increased by 30%, where the total exports were 2753 million dirhams.


The data showed that most of the exports were in foodstuffs, beverages, spirits, and tobacco products. The exports of this group were around 1870 million dirhams, followed by mineral products with 1051 million dirhams.

Based on the destination, exports to India were 11% in the third quarter of the year, exports to Iraq were 10%, and exports to Oman were 9% of total exports.

Exports By Main Trade Partner - Q3 - 2023




Re-exports

In the third quarter of 2023, the total of re-exports was around 629 million dirhams, increasing by 26% in comparison with the previous quarter (Q2-2023). By comparing it with the third quarter of the previous year, the data shows that there is a decrease in re-exports by 1%.

The data showed that re-exports of mineral products were 146 million dirhams and vehicles of transport were around 120 million dirhams.

Based on the trade partner out of total re-exports, the re-exports to Oman were 39%, 13% to Bahrain , and to Iraq 9%.
